## FRENCH CLASSES

L'Alliance Française de Fresno offers a variety of classes at all levels. The School uses modern methods that encourage active participation and place the emphasis on person-to-person exchange. It teaches conversational French as it is spoken today and pays great attention to good pronunciation, rapid comprehension and accurate self-expression from the very beginning. Students quickly gain confidence to communicate with the language and acquire the ability to understand spoken French from an early stage. Classes emphasize conversational French as well as French cultural themes.
